^{*} Please note, that the weekly pass is your child's responsibility. If they lose their pass, they will need to pay the 'per journey' fare until they can purchase a new pass the following Monday. There will also not be any refunds for unused travel e.g. if your child is absent from school, or attending an after-school club.

KAT cards

Students in Years 12 & 13 can buy a weekly KAT card for £12. With a KAT card students can travel on any Stagecoach or East Yorkshire bus in Hull and parts of East Riding as much as they like. Please contact the SM6 year office for further details.

East Riding Area

All pupils in Years 7 – 13 travelling from the East Riding area will need to buy a half-termly pass via ParentPay. The cost of the pass is based on the daily charges below for all days in the school half term and there is no reduction for days not travelled. In some circumstances, students can travel one way only, or part of the week, if there is availability. The cost of a one-way journey is £2.60. All payments must be made via ParentPay. All pupils travelling from the East Riding area will receive a pass from the school which they must show the driver each time they board the bus.

Eligibility for Free Transport

All children in Years 7-11 who are eligible for free transport will receive their bus pass from the school. Once they receive their pass, they must show it to the driver each time they board the bus.

Please note:

Parents must apply yearly for free transport via the online form on the HCC/ERYC websites. We suggest you do this around July time to ensure your application is processed in time for your child's return in September.

Eligibility for free transport ends when pupils leave Year 11.
