Tell them how great he is.


Sing praise to the Lord, because he has done great things.

T is for Teresa

St Teresa is the only saint associated with our school who has a whole building dedicated to her. She is also the newest of our saints. She was only canonised (declared to be a saint) in 2016 after a number of miracles were linked to her:—you can't become a saint without miracles. (Unless you are unlucky enough to become a martyr).



She was born in Macedonia and was originally called Agnes, but changed her name to Sister Teresa after studying in Ireland.

She joined the order of the Sisters of Loretta where she originally became a teacher and eventually a headteacher of the Loretta school in Calcutta. She was head there for 20 years but became more concerned with the plight of the poor children outside the school, than the lucky ones inside. So, she left to work with the street children of Calcutta. These were almost always orphans with no home and no way to earn enough money to live. This is what Mother Teresa became famous for and even won the Nobel Peace Prize for her work with the poor. She is probably the most famous Nun ever!!
