SMC6 (ER Area up to Robson Way)

HORNSEA (Rolston Road), police station, main road, past Honeysuckle Farm, Long Riston, Skirlough to Hull.

959 (Hull area from Papas)

Holderness Road, Southcoates Lane, Newbridge Road, Ellis Street, Mount Pleasant, Stoneferry Road, Clough Road, Cottingham Road, Cranbrook Avenue to **ST MARY'S COLLEGE**.
