Route	Overview	Minimum Entry Requirements
Level 3 Double Maths plus 2 additional A levels	Students studying Double Maths (A level Maths and Further Maths) may wish to take two additional A level courses alongside their Maths, to enable them to acquire three different subjects.	We will discuss this with applicants individually at interview but as a guideline, you will need to have a minimum of four grade 7s and three grade 6s at GCSE to study Double Maths and two other A levels. A minimum of Grade 7 is required in GCSE maths for this option.
Level 3 - A Level Route	3 A Levels (Opportunity for students to take a fourth A Level to be discussed on an individual basis.)	Minimum grade point average of 5 across at least 5 GCSEs, including English and Maths , alongside specific requirements for individual subjects. To be considered for a 4 th A level, students will need a grade point average of 6.75 from at least 7 GCSEs, and Maths, English and Science GCSEs must be from Higher Tier papers.
Level 3 - Combined Route	A mixture of 3 single qualifications from a range of A Level or Vocational Courses.	Minimum grade point average of 4.5 across at least 5 GCSEs, including English and Maths , alongside specific requirements for individual subjects. Merits or above from vocational courses will be taken into consideration.
Level 3 - Vocational Route	Triple vocational diploma or double diploma with a separate single option.	Minimum grade point average of 4 across at least 5 GCSEs alongside specific requirements for individual subjects, including English. GCSE Maths required at grade 3 or above. Merits or above from vocational courses will be taken into consideration.
Level 3 – T Level	Full Time T Level in either Health or Education and Early Years	Minimum grade point average of 4.5 across at least 5 GCSEs. Merits or above from vocational courses will be taken into consideration. (Must include Maths and English Grade 4 or higher.
Level 2 – Work Skills	Level 2 Work-Skills course alongside Maths and/or English re-sit	If a student doesn't qualify for the above routes, the Level 2 Work-skills option may be available alongside English and/or Maths re-sit. In some cases, this can lead onto progression to Level 3 routes. A minimum of Grade 3 in English and Grade 2 in Maths is required for this programme.
