



Y10 Revision – Phase 2 – January to March

Dear Parent/Carer,

This week your child received their mock results. Hopefully your child has shared these results with you but if not, they will shortly be available for you to view on your Edulink account. Many students have results to be proud of, but as is usually the case after the Christmas mocks, there is work to be done by all to ensure our Year 10 cohort fully achieve their potential in their summer exams. To ensure we are doing everything to help your child succeed, there will be a three-pronged supportive approach.

Next week your child will be given access to a revision timetable, allowing them to plan out their week whilst ensuring there is adequate time for both revision and social time. While this should be flexible, it allows your child to allocate time throughout their week for independent revision. Please review this with them.

Through the Year 10 Google Classroom, from WC Monday 16th January we are launching our Guided Revision Programme providing a week-by-week guide for all exam subjects directing students what to revise, how to do it as well as providing resources to facilitate this. The expectation is that students spend 20-30 minutes per subject per week using this resource to empower their independent revision, ensuring there is enough structure and guidance allowing all to achieve. Please ensure your child keeps all resources they produce as the programme is designed to cover all major topics in all subjects up to the summer examinations. Students who revise independently are more confident going into their exams and give themselves the best chance of success.

Finally, Phase 2 of our in-person revision offer commences Monday 16th January, the timetable for this is overleaf. The expectation is that students will attend at least three revision sessions per week, though last term many of our students benefitted from attending more. There will be rewards for attending each session, weekly spot prizes and the end of phase grand draw. Attendance at revision will be tracked weekly via EduLink, but please do not hesitate to contact the year office if you have any queries. This phase will last for 6 school weeks and lead up to the March assessment week. **There are only 14 school weeks until the summer examinations begin, and it is imperative that we work together to maximise these opportunities for our students.**
