### Y11 Revision – Phase 2 – January to March

Dear Parent/Carer,

Following on from the Winter mocks I'm writing to inform you of upcoming revision and support for your child. Many students have results to be proud of, but as is usually the case after the Christmas mocks, there is work to be done by all to ensure our Year 11 cohort fully achieve their potential in their summer exams. To ensure we are doing everything to help your child succeed, there will be a three-pronged supportive approach.

Through the Year 11 Google Classroom, we continue our 'Guided Revision Programme' providing a week-by-week guide for all exam subjects directing students what to revise, how to do it as well as providing resources to facilitate this. The expectation is that students spend 20-30 minutes per subject per week using this resource to empower their independent revision, ensuring there is enough structure and guidance allowing all to achieve. Please ensure your child keeps all the resources they produce as the programme is designed to cover all major topics in all subjects up to the summer examinations. Students who revise independently are more confident going into their exams and give themselves the best chance of success.

Continuing the development from the winter mocks, and as per the schedule shared with students on the Year 11 Google Classroom, students will sit their February 'Mini Mocks' where will sit **one paper** under examination conditions in English, Maths and where relevant MFL. Further to this they will also sit their Paper 1 mock for Biology and Chemistry. These will be in the final week of this half term.

Finally, Phase 2 of our 'in-person' revision offer commences on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> January, the timetable for this is overleaf. The expectation is that students will attend at least three revision sessions per week, though last term many of our students benefitted from attending more. There will be rewards for attending each session, weekly spot prizes and the end of phase grand draw. Attendance at revision will be tracked weekly via EduLink, but please do not hesitate to contact the year office if you have any queries. This phase will last for 6 school weeks and lead up to the March assessment week, the final assessment period before your child begins their summer examinations. **There are only 13 school weeks until the summer examinations begin, and it is imperative that we work together to maximise these opportunities for our students.**
